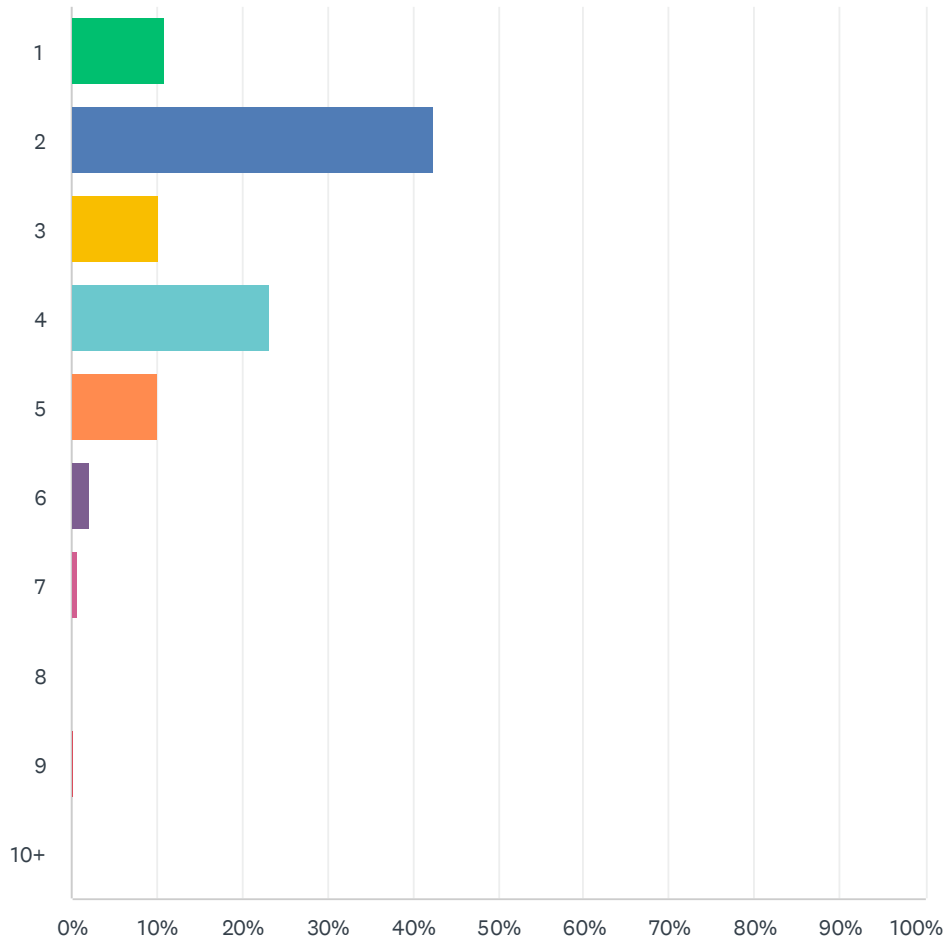


Q1 How many people are in your household?

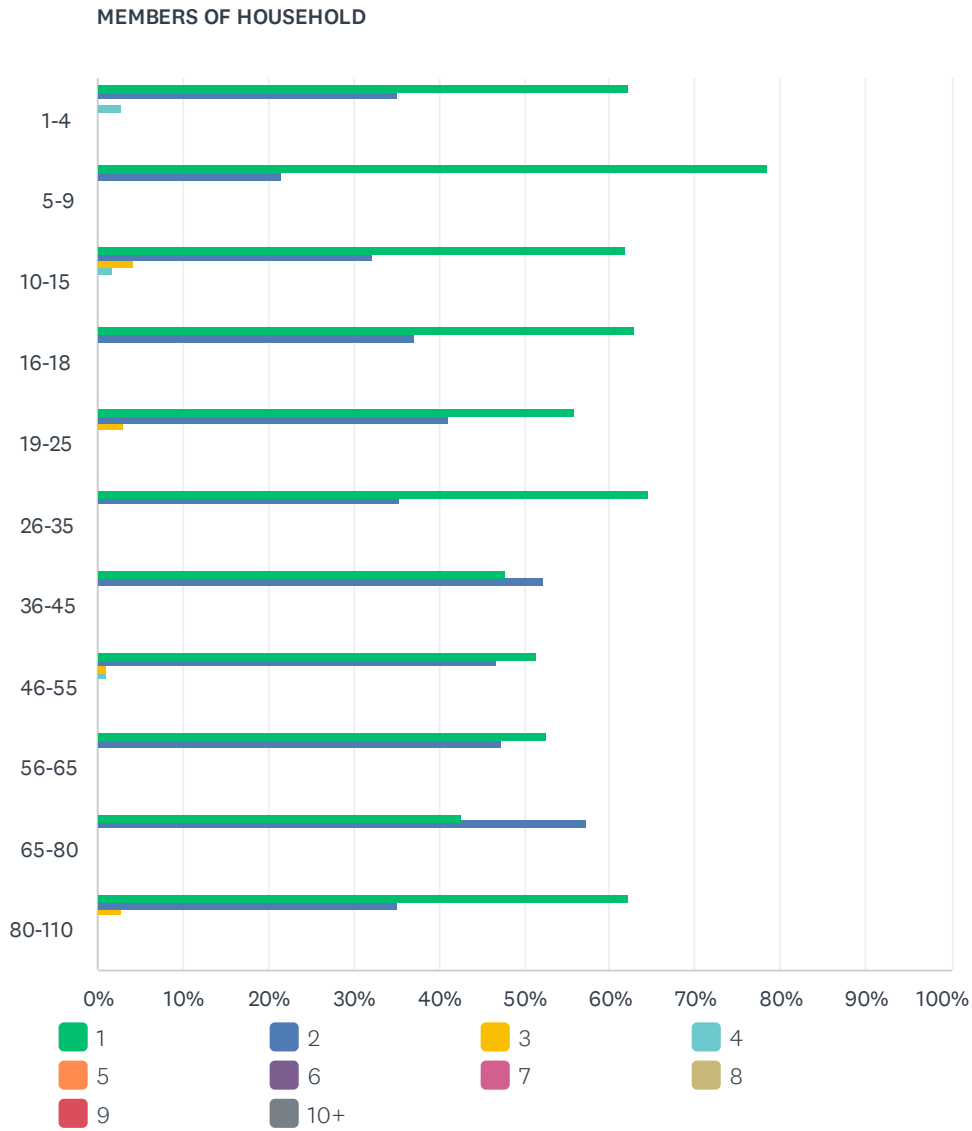

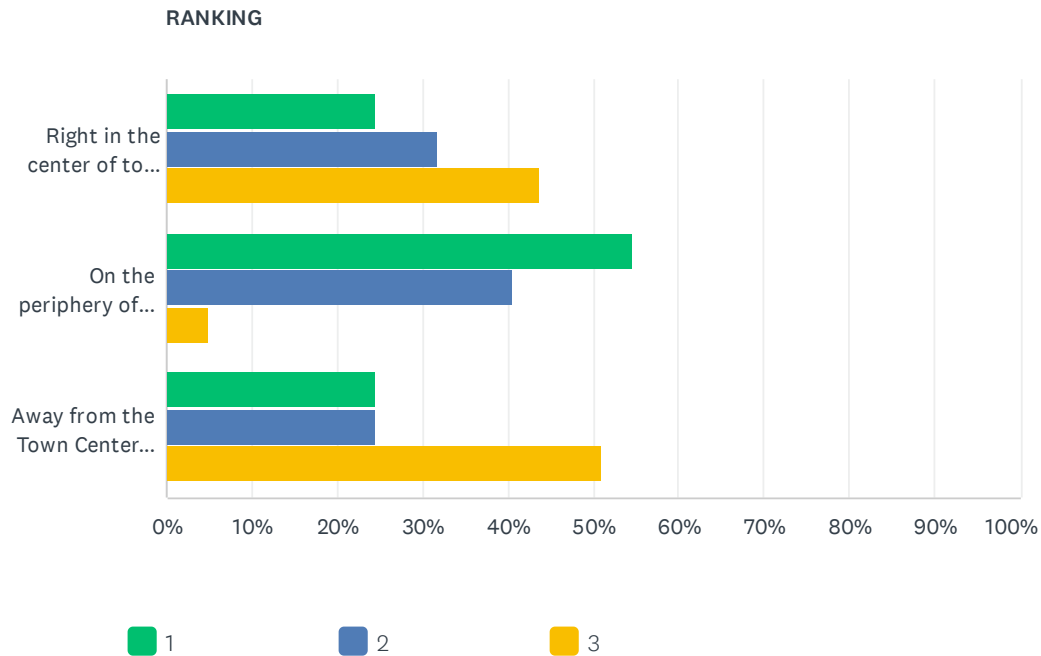
