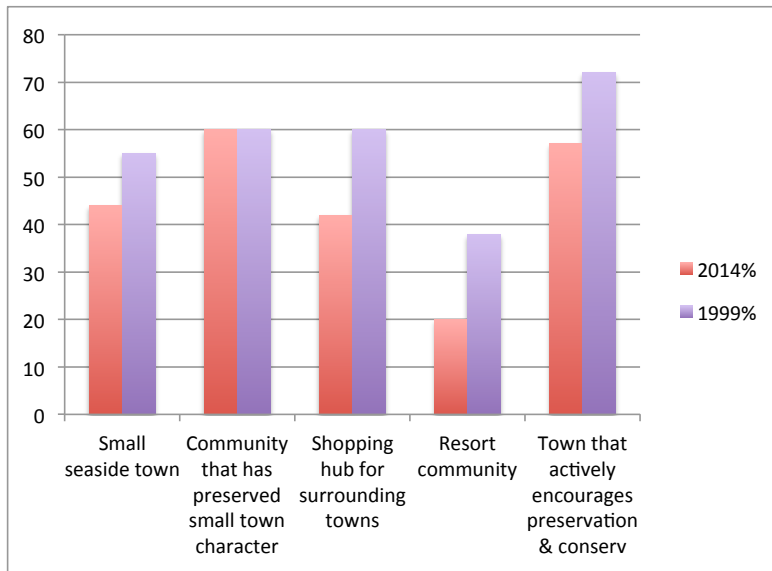

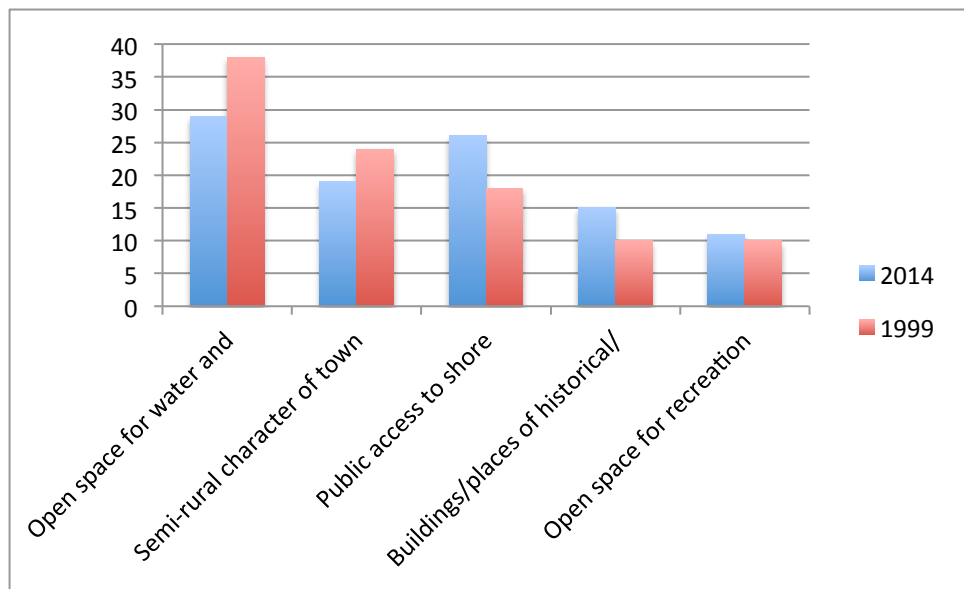

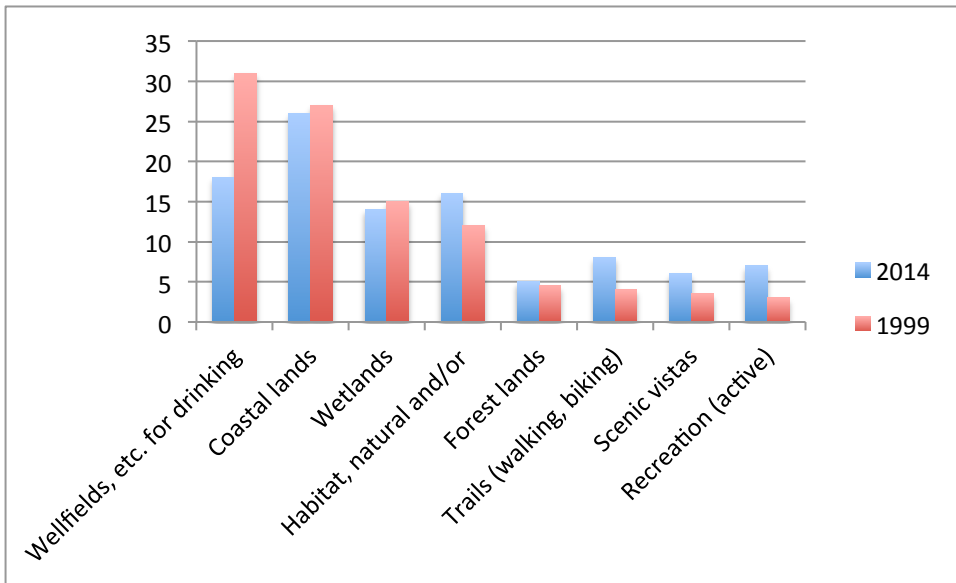

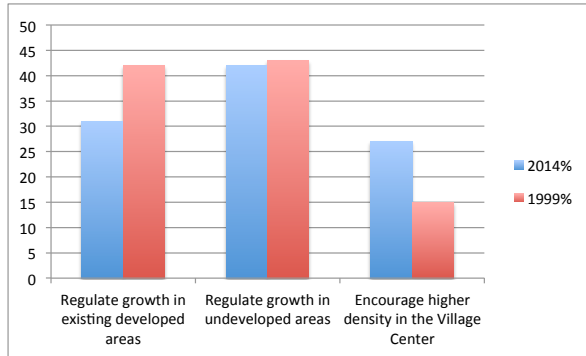

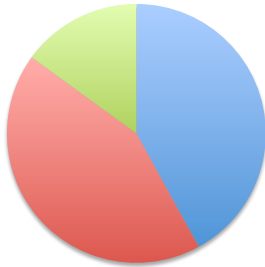

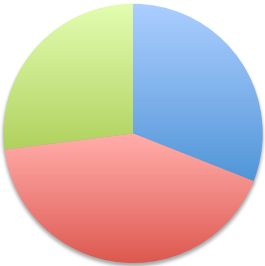

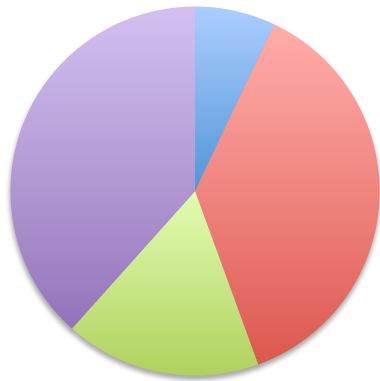

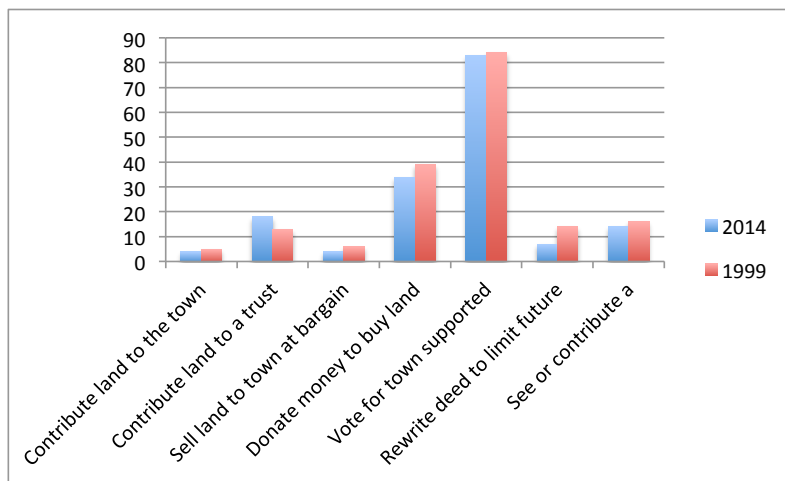

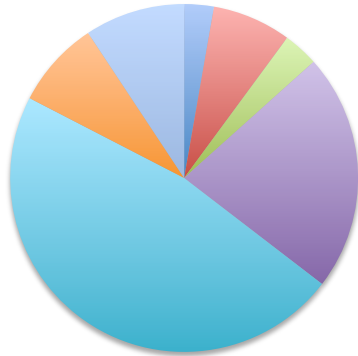

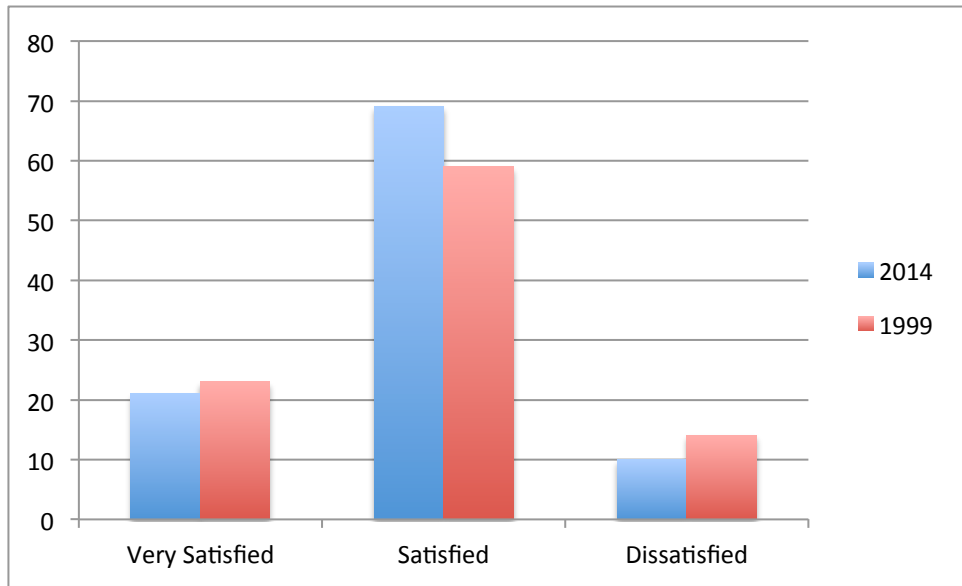
Q7: How satisfied are you with the places for children and youth to play and recreate in town?

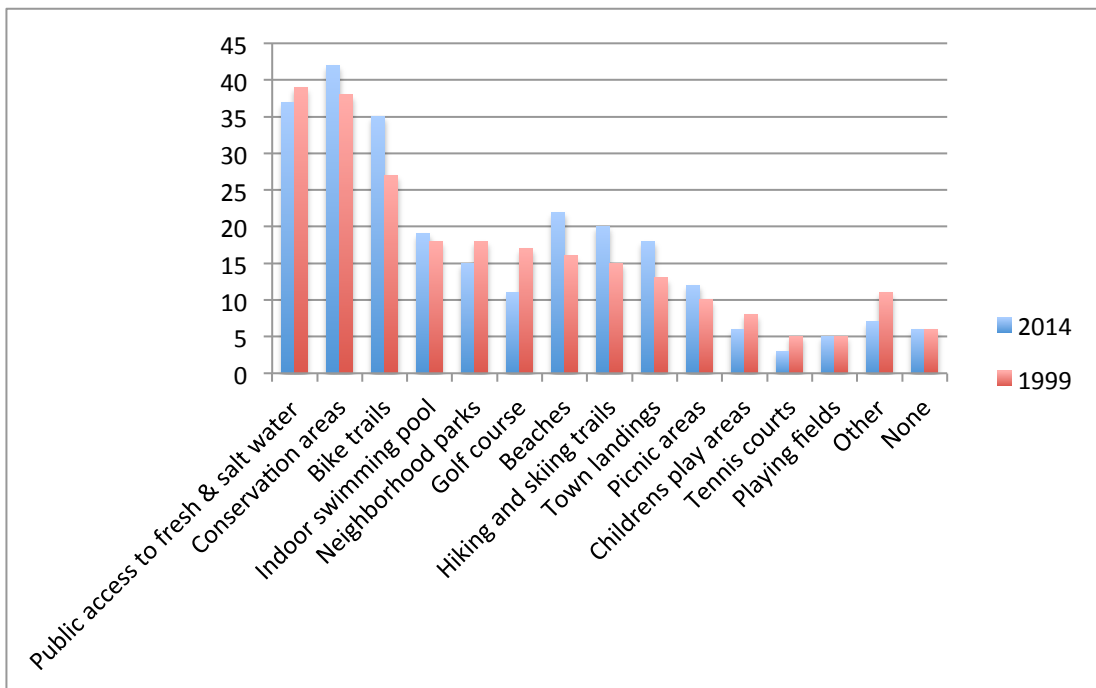

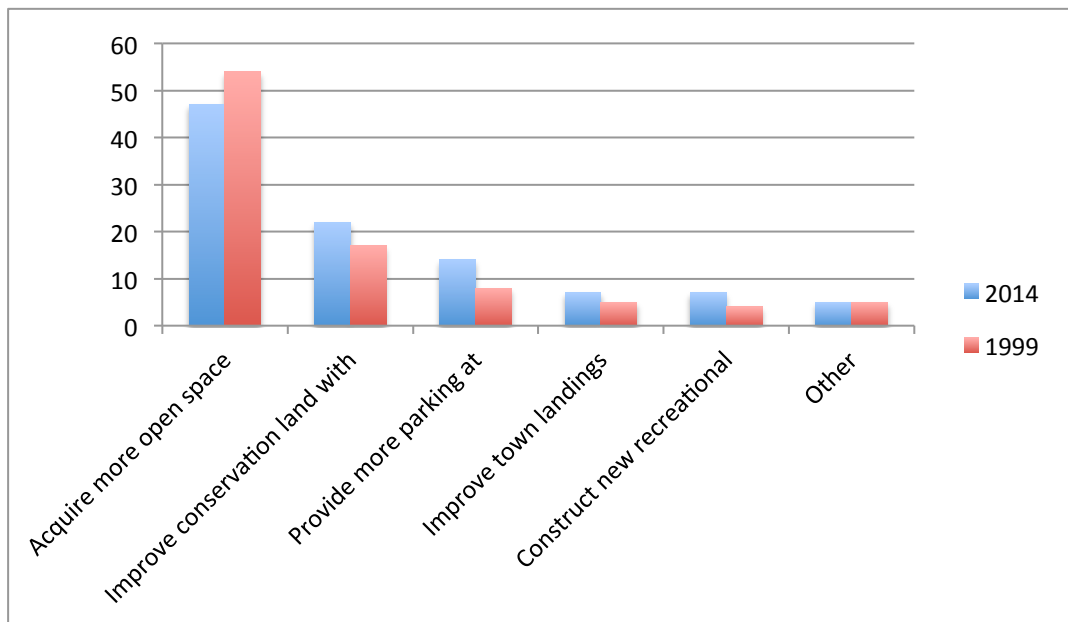

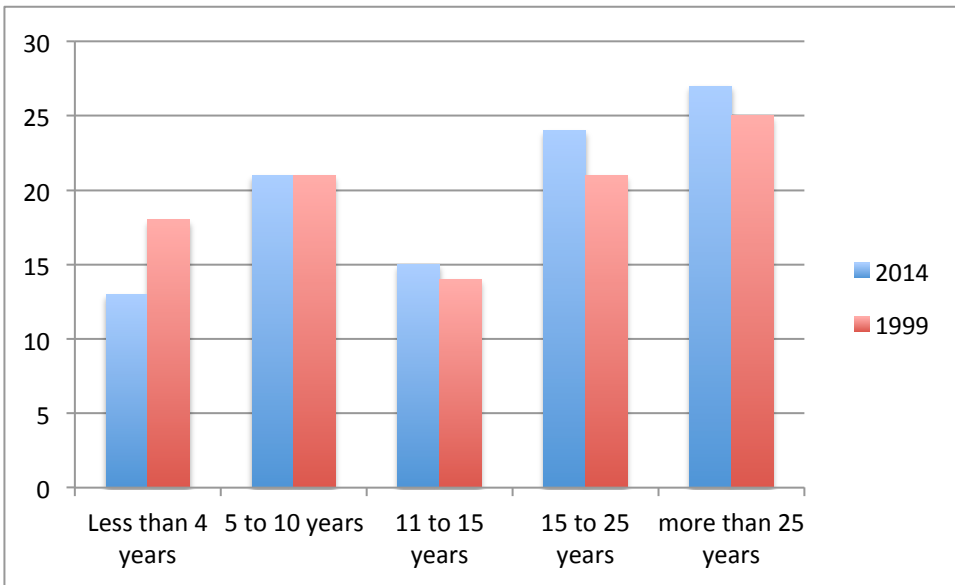

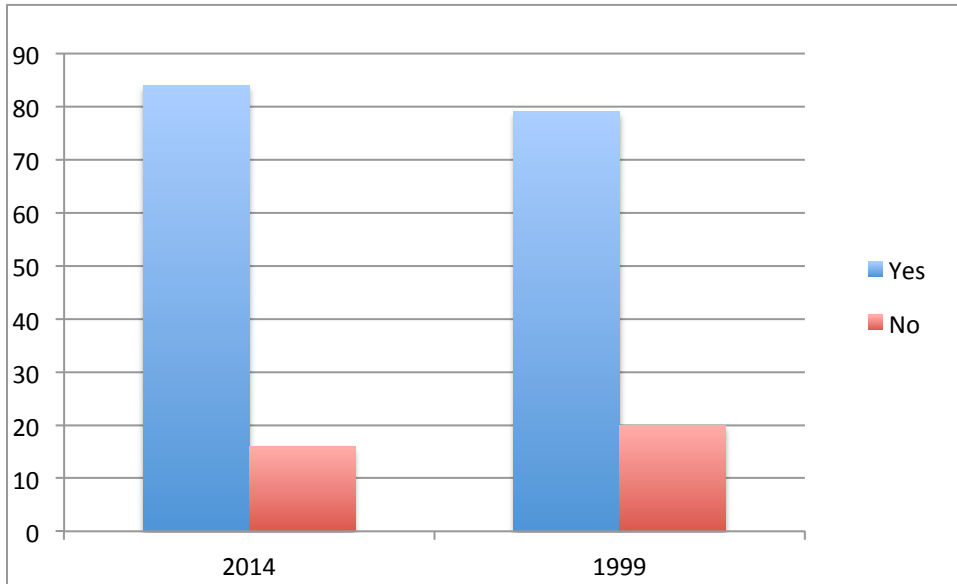

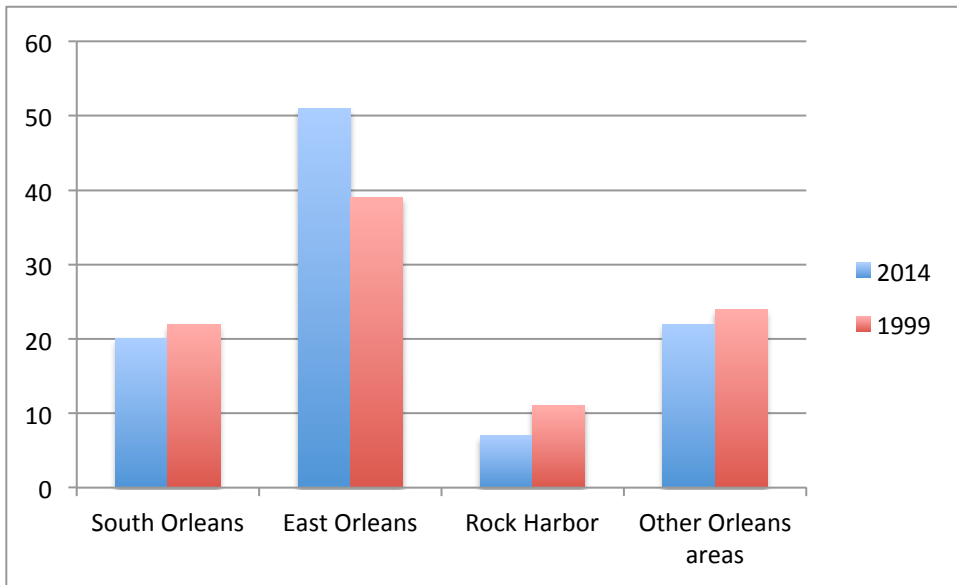
